Agenda

Explanation of Lesson & Introductions (15 Minutes)

- Animal Name Game Ice Breaker
- Introduce topic of child rights and SDGs
- Set rules and expectations

Activity 1 (30 Minutes)

- Assign students groups
- Instruct students to create group names, elect roles for each student (leader, writer, question poser), and get to know one another with a team-building activity

Vocabulary (45 Minutes)

- Introduce vocabulary words
- Lead vocabulary exercise: Reader/ Writer

Activity 2 (30 Minutes)

- In groups, instruct students to begin creating a list of all the challenges they and their community face
- Have each group share and discuss their lists

Review: Making a Difference (30 Minutes)

- As one large groups, introduce the 2030 Agenda and review the SDGs

Reflections & Appreciations (15 Minutes)

Facilitators will introduce the reflection and appreciation time. At the end of every day we will give you time to write in your books any thoughts or drawings of thing you learned and thought about throughout the day. We will also have time to appreciate the contributions students made throughout the day.
