The official announcement of the financing for the titling of 90 thousand properties through the project “Improvement of the Cadastral Service, Titling and Registration of rural properties in the 10 provinces of San Martín”, was the great good news of the inter-institutional agreement signed between the Regional Government of San Martín and the Ministry of Agriculture and Irrigation (Minagri).

After a prolonged working meeting of officials, managers and technical teams of both institutions, it was led by the regional governor, Pedro Bogarín and the Deputy Minister of Development and Infrastructure for Agriculture and Irrigation, Carlos Ynga, the signing of a nourished agreement that includes the articulation of several institutions dependent on Minagri.

In addition to the expected degree that will take two years, enabling access to credits and strengthening the productive revolution, Minagri will have specialists at the “Sisa River Reservoir” project, which will benefit 1,494 producers and irrigate 3,000 hectares.

The deputy minister also stressed that 3 thousand 300 hectares of cultivated pastures will be installed to benefit more than 2 538 small farmers in 18 districts of El Dorado, Huallaga, Lamas, Moyobamba, San Martín, Tocache, Bellavista and Rioja. The investment will be 2.6 million soles.

Through Agrorural, the improvement of the hydraulic electromechanical system of the irrigation intake - Sisa river will be completed in February and this quarter the improvement of bocatomas will be completed in Nuevo Cajamarca, Soritor, Pardo Miguel, Awajun, Yorongos and Moyobamba.
