



Since 2015, over 1 million refugees have made the treacherous journey over land and sea to seek asylum in Europe. While some have been resettled, thousands are still trapped in camps – the largest of which is Moria Refugee Camp in Lesbos, Greece.

Fenix Humanitarian Legal Aid is the only full time legal team working just outside Moria's gates. Since we began operations in December 2018, we have provided over 1,000 clients with comprehensive legal support as well as psychological, medical, and protection assistance. With this support, clients have the information they need to advocate for themselves and their case in asylum interviews.

Their asylum interview determines their future: whether they are allowed to leave Moria and stay in Europe or whether they will be sent back to Turkey or back home. Still, asylum seekers are forced into interviews with no preparation or information.

We believe this must change. A team of world-class lawyers and legal assistants from Harvard and Oxford, we believe information about the asylum process is a human right – and we are committed to providing it. We are also the only legal organization providing comprehensive assistance – giving our clients the psychological support, protection, and information they need to demand respect and regain dignity in the asylum process.
